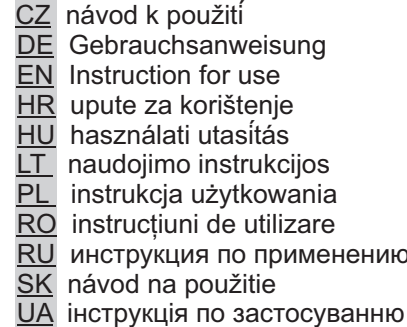




ELASH SHORT B

INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION FOR USERS

Product: "ART. MAS" Export-Import Jacek Birczyk, Wojciech Birczyk Sp. z o.o. 26-600 Radom, ul. Kołkiewskiego 64, Poland. This product belongs to the Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) class as defined in the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union 1016/425 dated 9 March 2016. This product has been classified as Category II Standards: The product complies with standards: EN ISO 20471:2013, High visibility clothing", EN 343:2019 - "Protective clothing", "Protection against rain", EN ISO 13688:2013 "Protective clothing-general requirements". Type examination of PPE is conducted by Notified body (NB) 2474: MIRT-CONTROL d.o.o. **Javorińska 3**, 10040 Zagreb - Dubrava, Croatia, **Purpose:** This high visibility clothing is intended to provide conspicuity of the wearer in any light condition when viewed by operators of vehicles or other mechanized equipment during daylight conditions and under illumination of headlights in the dark, and to provide protection against the effects of precipitation (e.g. rain, snow, fog, and humidity. **Attention:** The jacket have removable sleeves with a zip. Jacket worn with sleeves have **3** the material surface class in accordance with EN ISO 20471: 2013. If the jacket is worn without sleeves, the **class 3** cannot be obtained. The bodywarmer – jacket without sleeves have **2** the material surface class. **Usage:** Ensuring the protective function of the product depends on the personal responsibility of the user. At the stage of selection user should pay attention to proper use of the product. The intended use of the product is for protection against precipitation. If the clothing is worn with the protective clothing for special risks, total protection functions should be guaranteed, depending on the destination. In any case, the requirements shall take priority. Before use, the user should check at his own risk if clothing is suitable for the intended work activities, is complete and that all protection functions are provided. The materials from which the product is made, should not adversely affect user hygiene or health. However, any material contained in the material of the article or component which is the product may be an allergen, e.g. Cotton, leather, metal, polyurethane, dyes, etc. People particularly sensitive recommended against the use of prior testing of the product. **Size selection:** The product should be the correct size corresponding to the dimensions of the user's body. The size should be adjusted by trying on the product before use. Size of the product with the size expressed in cm is given on the label sewn to the product (figure 1). **Shelf life:** The clothing is suitable for long-term storage. The storage conditions of the product should be: absence of water, insects, clothing in which there are damages, should be considered not fit for use and immediately withdraw from the use - replaced. **Storage:** Clothes should be stored on shelves or hangers in a dry and well-ventilated place at 5 - 25 °C, with moderate humidity, not less than 15 m from heating devices and lighting points, in conditions that protect it from getting wet, dirt, mechanical damage, chemical agents. Too much humidity, temperature or intense light may adversely affect the quality of stored clothes. The manufacturer is not responsible for defects or damage to clothes caused due to incorrect terms and conditions of storage, maintenance and use. **Maintenance:** Maintenance should be carried out in accordance with the provision of maintenance specified on the label sewn to the product. Always wash inside out. Jacket retains the properties for 5 washing cycles (max 5). The stated maximum number of cleaning cycles is not the only factor related to the lifetime of the garment. The lifetime will also depend on usage, care storage, etc. Always after use and after cleaning should be dried in a well-ventilated place. **Repair:** The jacket is not designed for repair. If there is a tear, abrasion, tear seams, holes, damaged fasteners, intensive dirt). Clothes having a damage should be immediately withdrawn from use and replaced by the new one. The Supplier shall not assume any liability for damages and disadvantages of the product resulting from incorrect use of the product and improper, maintenance and storage. **The method of packaging and transport conditions:** Products are packed in a foil packs and then in a cardboard box. Goods should be transported in manufacturer's packaging. During loading, transportation and unloading packaging should not be exposed to mechanical damage. Technical conditions of transport should ensure protection from damage, deformation, splashes, dirt. The manufacturer is not liable for damage and effects of the product resulting from the use of the product that is not in accordance with the intended use and improper method, maintenance and storage. This manual is an integral part of the package and should be kept with the product. **Labeling:** The product is labeled in accordance with the manufacturer's packaging. During loading, transportation and unloading should pay attention to the product and packaging not be exposed to mechanical damage. Technical conditions of transport should guarantee protection against damage, deformation, wetting, soiling. **Utilization:** Dispose of used products should be disposed of in accordance with applicable national regulations and standards for the protection of the environment. Each product has the required markings in the form of tags sewn into the product. **Explanation of symbols used in the labeling of the product and graphic symbols informing about the method of product maintenance:**  mark of conformity - stating that at the product meets the requirements of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union 1016/425 dated 9 March 2016, **Kat.
